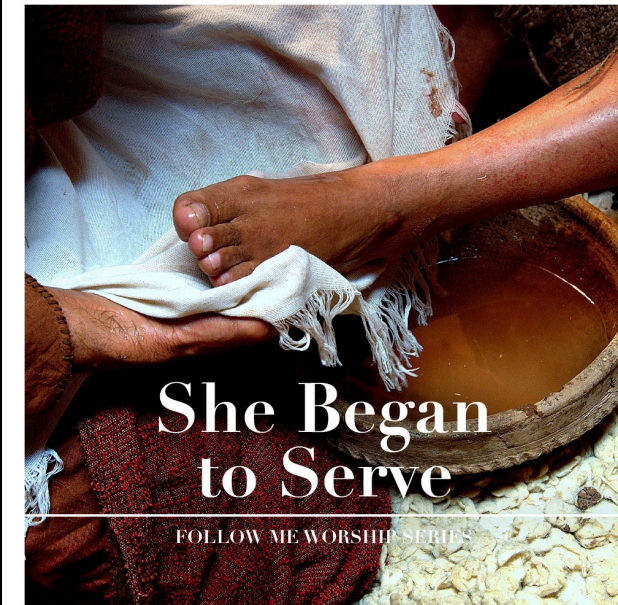

***CALL TO WORSHIP**

L: The God does not award prizes for the most flowery speeches or the most eloquent presentations. He only asks us to tell others about Jesus, through our words, and also through our lives the manner in which we live on a daily basis can convey the message better than all the greatest orations we can deliver.

P: **O God, guide our tongues, that we say only what is true and helpful. Guide our lives, that we, too may bring Your message to a world hungry for it!**
