***CALL TO WORSHIP**

L: The kingdom of God is like a mustard seed. Although mustard seeds are tiny, great shrubs grow from them.

P: **We do not understand how this can be. Why is Heaven like a mustard seed? How can great shrubs grow from something as small as a mustard seed?**

L: God created mustard seeds to grow into large shrubs so that birds could shelter in their branches, and the plants could produce much seed for them to eat. The seed does not do this by itself, through its own power, but because God created it for this purpose and provides what is needed to nourish the plant. God also created us to fulfill His purpose, not by ourselves, but by God working through us.
