***CALL TO WORSHIP**

L: When King David wanted to build a house for God, he was told that he was not the one to do so. That would fall to his son to complete. God has a job for each of us, but He does not expect or want any of us to have to do everything.

P: **Who shall ascend the hill of the Lord? Who shall dwell in His holy place?**

L: We are each to do our share of the labor, but no one is expected to do everything alone. Just as Jesus wanted his disciples to rest after they had worked hard, so God wants each of us to rest. Indeed, He set aside the Sabbath for this purpose.

P: **How can we rest when there is work still to be done?**

L: Are there those among you who have time to spare to assist with the labor? Seek them out and encourage them to participate in it. Are any of you so demanding or so perfectionistic that others are afraid they cannot ever meet your standards? Remember that no one is perfect, and even the most talented or demanding can use help.

P: **Lord forgive us when we do not do our share of Your work, but also forgive us when we assume that we are so important or capable that nothing will be done correctly if we don't do it ourselves. Remind us that while You have work for each of us, You do not expect or desire any of us to work all by ourselves at the labors You have for us.**
