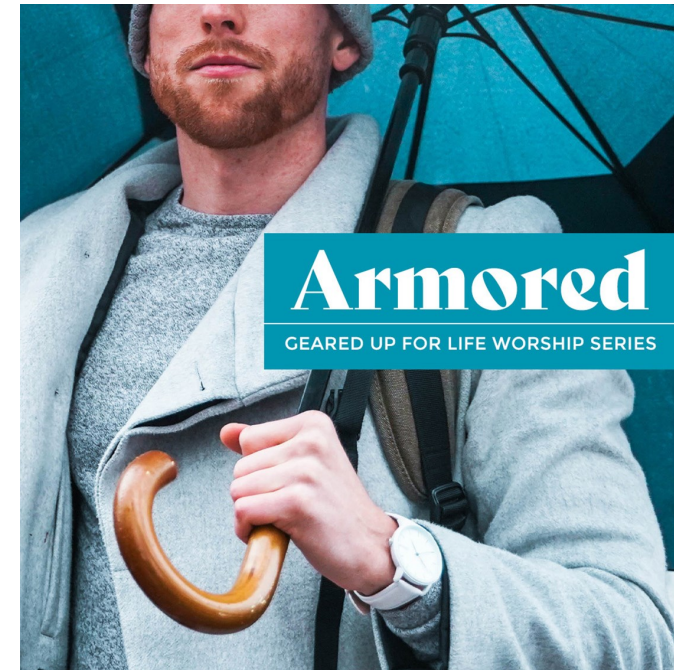

***CALL TO WORSHIP**
