

*CALL TO WORSHIP

L: The Bible tells us that prayers of faith will save the sick.

P: We often pray for those among us who are sick, and often they are healed. Yet there are times when the sick for whom we pray are not healed. Why is this?

L: Sometimes God gives a different answer than we want or expect. We do not always understand why. Sometimes we expect a sick body to be healed and instead it is the sick spirit which is healed. We do not always recognize this, but we can fully trust that God hears our prayers and that His response is the right one.

P: The Bible says that the prayer of the righteous is powerful and effective, yet sometimes we pray and nothing happens. Why is this?

L: Sometimes we pray in good faith, but for the wrong thing. God will give us what we need, not necessarily what we want. At other times God does hear, and He answers our prayer, but in His time, not ours. Sometimes we need to pray with greater fervor and greater faith. Sometimes His answer is "No." In all times, we can trust God to hear us and do what is right for us.

P: O God, hear our prayers, and strengthen our faith so that we trust in You completely to answer us with Your answers, rather than ours. Give us the faith to know that You are always there, always hear us, and always act according to our needs and Your wisdom, even when we do not recognize this.
