*CALL TO WORSHIP

L: The *Bible* says that nothing can separate us from our God. Nothing. Yet throughout the ages people have despaired because God seems so far away. Even Jesus, while hanging on the cross, felt that God had forsaken Him. How can this be?

P: We, too, sometimes feel that God has moved away from us. We call on Him, but He is not there. Why not?

L: Sometimes we move away from God to follow our own will. Sometimes we are so distracted by our attraction to our own possessions, our own agendas and desires, that we do not attend to God but let those things draw us away from Him.

P: It is true that people do indeed let their things, their activities, and the worldly demands on their time draw us away from God. However this does not apply to Jesus. Why did He feel God had abandoned Him?

L: Jesus was separated from God by the same thing which separates us from God: sin. For us, it is our own sins which separate us. In the case of Jesus, who was sinless, it is our sins which separated Him from God. Jesus took our sins upon Himself that we might have a relationship with God. He paid a very high price for us. How then can we not repent of our sins and allow God to enter our hearts?

P: O God, forgive us our hardness of heart, our proclivity to sin, and our desire to blame You when we draw away from You to follow our own sinful ways. Enter into our lives today, and keep us from the harm we would cause ourselves by following our own desires rather than obeying You.
