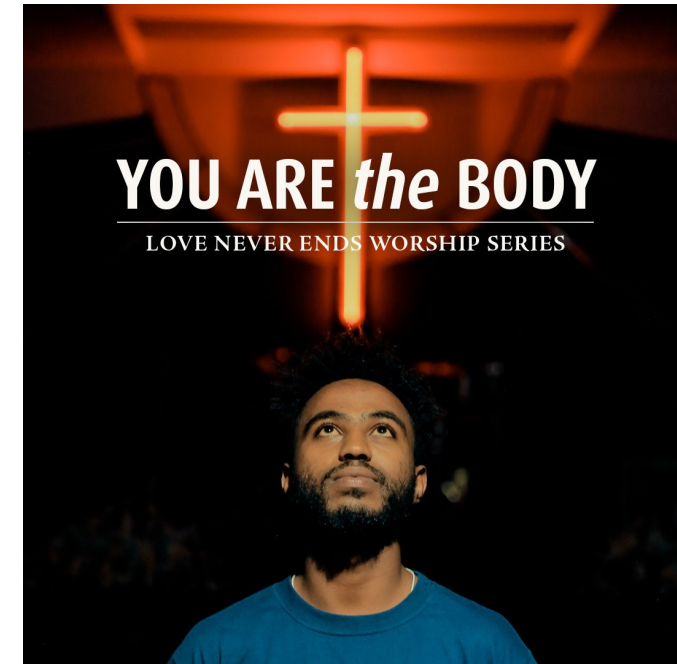

***CALL TO WORSHIP**

L: Rejoice, for each of us is important to the work of the church!

P: We all know that some of us are important, but perhaps most of us aren’t really that necessary. It won’t matter if we just come to church now and then and do nothing else.

L: ALL are needed! A person has two eyes because two are much better than one. You can get by with only one if that is all you have, but two are much better because you need two for depth perception. L: Can you smile? Smile at others in church! Can you say hello to people? Greet others in church, especially those you do not know. Can you sweep the floor, or wash dishes, or cook for a coffee hour? A church needs all of its members, and all of their skills.

P: Dear Father, show us how we can use the skills you have given us in your service, and remind us that you don’t give people worthless abilities, but useful ones. Further, you give each of us abilities. Show us each how to recognize those abilities and how to use them to serve you.
