***CALL TO WORSHIP**

L: It is written that if a person confesses that Jesus is Lord and believes that God raised Him from the dead, that person will be saved.

P: We believe these things, and confess that Jesus is the Lord, the Son of God, and was raised from the dead. Still, sometimes we have doubts.

L: Shortly after Jesus was baptized by John, He went into the wilderness, where He fasted for 40 days. There He was tempted by the devil, but He did not yield to temptation.

P: We too are often tempted. Sometimes we resist successfully. At other times we yield to the temptations about us.

L: Lent is a time for reflection and meditation. It is a time to draw closer to the God Who has provided for the salvation of His people. How shall we respond to the temptations around us? How shall we respond when people mock our beliefs about Jesus and would draw us away from Him?

P: O God, strengthen us in the times of temptation, that we can withstand anything which would draw us away from You. Give us the courage to acknowledge that Jesus is Lord, that He is risen, and that we invite Him into our hearts.
