*CALL TO WORSHIP

L: What do we wish for those who persecute us? Retribution? Retaliation? Bad things? At the very least most of us would wish our tormenter would go away and leave us alone. So what do we wish for such a person?

P: Most of us do wish, at the very least, to be left alone. It is tempting to wish for some sort of retaliation or punishment, even though we know that we are supposed to pray for our enemies.

L: When Paul was in chains before King Agrippa, he wished that the king was a Christian like Paul himself was!

P: It would be very difficult to wish such a thing for one who is abusing us!

L: Paul knew that one way to get rid of an enemy is to make a friend of him. While he may have recognized that this was unlikely to happen with King Agrippa, he also knew that turning him into a fellow Christian would be of great value to both Agrippa, and to all Christians in Israel. He could at least try. If he did not try, there would be no chance that Agrippa would become a Christian.

P: Lord, help us to see our enemies as potential friends. Remind us that if we try and fail to reach someone, we have done all we can do, and that is all that is asked of us. If we do not try, we cannot succeed, and we have failed to do even that which we could have done.
