***CALL TO WORSHIP**

L: In many ways, Christians are a team. Team members are expected to work together for the good of the whole team. If one goes astray, the others should gently return that member to the right way. Otherwise, the whole team may suffer.

P: **We need, but often do not like, to be corrected. Keep us focused, O Lord, on what is the good and right thing to do for the whole team. Help us accept correction when that is what is needed.**

L: Do the best you can do, not comparing yourselves with others. To do that could result in pride and arrogance if you think you are doing better than the others, or discouragement and a tendency to give up if you feel you fall short.

P: **Remind us that if we are doing our best, that is all that is asked, and we can be satisfied with our performance. Let us strive to always do our best.**

L: Each team member must carry his or her own load, not assuming that others will do for you what you should and can do for yourselves. However, if one has more than he or she can handle, help that person until the load again becomes manageable for him or her.

P: **Above all, O Lord, remind us that You are the team captain, and that if we are following You, we will ultimately win the game!**
