

#### \*CALL TO WORSHIP

- L: We are told that God loves everyone, even though He may hate the things some people do. Would we welcome Adolf Hitler, or Joseph Stalin, or a mass murderer who had just destroyed our family?
- P: O Lord, help us to forgive even those whose actions we cannot love. If we are honest with ourselves, we acknowledge that we do not love those we find too evil, or who have been too hurtful to us. In such situations, please forgive our unwillingness to love, and help us forgive such people. Remind us that You forgive such people if they truly repent, and we are to do the same.
