*CALL TO WORSHIP:

L: When Jesus went into the wilderness to be baptized by John, John protested that he was not good enough to even untie the sandals Jesus wore on his feet. Jesus insisted on being baptized anyway, so John obliged Him.

P: Why should Jesus, the sinless one, insist on being baptized? He had no sins of which to repent, and no need of the Holy Spirit to enter His life, for He and the Holy Spirit are one.

L: Jesus lived His life as an example to those who witnessed Him, so that they might follow His example and live. He was baptized not because He needed it, but because we need it.

If He chooses to cause a miracle to happen, He will do so without our assistance. It is enough that we allow Him to use us to further His work.
