*CALL TO WORSHIP:

L: Our God is a God of love. He loves us so much that He sent his Son Jesus to die for us, as unworthy as we are. Does this not prove how great His love for us is?

P: We are awed by this great love. We cannot fully comprehend it, for we know people are sometimes not very easy to love. Who can love a Hitler, or a Stalin? Yet even these people whom we find totally evil were loved by a few who knew them well.

L: Yes, people, all people, can be unlovable at times. Yet we are told to love one another, just as God loves us. Further, we are told to love not just in word alone, but also in deed. Our actions speak louder than our words, and we are to show our love through our actions.

P: This is hard for us. It can be hard to speak words of love and show loving actions when we are confronted by people who abuse us and treat us badly. We do not want to love such people!

L: God loves all of us, all the time. That does not mean that He loves all of our actions. Indeed, He cannot love the evil we do or the hurtful and untrue words we say. That is why He corrects us when we are wrong, just as a loving parent corrects the misbehaving child. But still, He loves us. Do we believe this?

P: O Dear God, help us to see and to fully believe that Your love for us in unending, even when we do what is wrong. Help us to understand when You correct us that You do so because You love us, not to hurt us or get even with us. Help us also to love others just as You love us, even when they do what is wrong, even though we cannot love the wrong they do.
