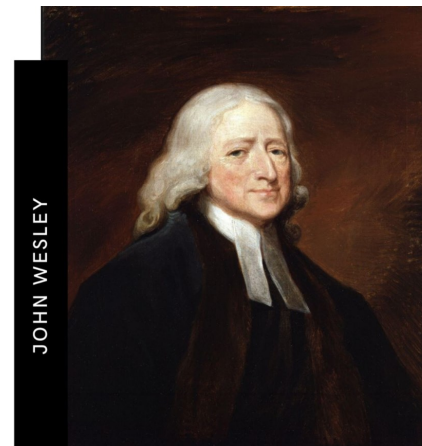

***CALL TO WORSHIP:**

L: The *Bible* says, “Judge not, that ye be not judged.”

P: How can we not judge? We need to discriminate between good and evil!

L: We are not told to refrain from using good judgment. We are expected to determine whether a thing is good or bad, harmful or safe, pleasing to God or evil in His sight. Rather, we are not to judge people as intrinsically good or bad simply because they may do things differently than we do ourselves.

P: People do not all worship in the same way. Is there not a set way in which we should worship?

L: God does not care whether we stand or sit when we pray, or whether we sing or do not sing in church. He knows that there are many ways to worship. Whatever you do to worship, heed the needs of others so that they are not caused to stumble by the manner in which you worship.

P: O God, strengthen our desire to want to serve You by doing what You would have us do and be as Christians. Guide us daily that we do not hurt or weaken the faith of others by the examples we set. Above all, help us to love and serve our neighbors, and to live in peace with them.
