

*CALL TO WORSHIP:

L: Following Jesus' crucifixion and resurrection, He appeared several times to His disciples that they might believe without any doubts.

P: If we would be His disciples, we also should believe without doubts. However, we have never seen Him in the flesh, and sometimes we wonder...

L: On one occasion, Jesus breathed on the disciples and told them to receive the Holy Spirit, which allowed the Holy Spirit to work through them to reach others. We also need the Holy Spirit within us to be effective disciples of Jesus. Do we receive the Holy Spirit?

P: Some feel the Holy Spirit working within them. Others do not recognize the working of the Holy Spirit, and they still wonder...

L: Thomas was not present when Jesus first appeared to the disciples, and refused to believe what they told him about having seen the resurrected Jesus. He indicated that unless he saw Jesus himself, he would not believe. Then Jesus appeared among them and Thomas also believed.

P: O Lord, thank You for coming to Thomas again. Help us to remember Your words to him, that Thomas believed after he saw Jesus for himself, but blessed are those who have not seen but still come to believe. Help us to believe even though we have not seen You in the flesh!
