*CALL TO WORSHIP:

L: Today is Pentecost, often celebrated as the birthday of the Christian church. On this day the Holy Spirit filled the followers of Jesus from every land who were gathered together in Jerusalem and enabled them to speak and understand in all the languages represented there.

P: **How wonderful are Your works, O God! But how do we get the Holy Spirit within us?**
