*CALL TO WORSHIP:

L: We are told that if we ask God for something He will give it to us. If we seek something, we will find it. If we knock, the door will be opened to us. Is this always true?

P: How can this be? We often ask for things we do not receive. We pray for a sick person to be healed and he dies. We ask for help in finding a job and there are none to be found. Why?

L: When we ask, do we believe that God will answer as we want Him to? If we seek and the thing we are seeking is not good for us, does God give it to us? Instead of telling God what we want, do we ask Him what He wants for us?

P: We may sometimes seek our own way and be disappointed when we do not get it. We also may sometimes want something which actually would not be good for us, even though we think it is. We also might sometimes not ask God what He wants for us because we fear the answer will be something we won't like or can't do.

L: Trust God. Whatever He wants for us will be good for us, whether or not we can see that at the time. Trust God. If He asks something from us, He will provide the means for us to do what He asks. Trust God!!!

P: O Lord, forgive us for our lack of faith in You. Remind us that whatever You give us is for our good. Whatever You ask us to do, You will give us the means to do. Strengthen our faith in You, O Lord!
