#### \*CALL TO WORSHIP:

L: Paul was one of the most dedicated apostles who followed Jesus, yet before he became a Christ follower, he persecuted Christians unmercifully, having them put to death when he could. Jesus can use even the worst of sinners to bring others to Himself! He can use each one of us, if we let Him.

P: We too are sinners, but we are not the worst of sinners. We don't have people put to death, or commit terrible crimes. We are just ordinary sinners, mostly doing little sins.

ALL: Dear God, forgive us for following our own way instead of Your way. Draw us to Your will, and correct us when we turn aside from your way. Mold us to Your way so that it becomes our way.
